### LET'S DO SOMETHING DIFFERENT!..

Come and join Catherine on this fun and innovative workshop. This workshop will bring together some new ideas for you to consider and explore, learning new techniques and ideas in composition.

During the weekend you will explore various ways to create your painting. Start with a simple charcoal or pencil drawing or a texta pen you create the initial idea. Catherine will show you how to use the pastel in its purest form and layering it up onto the canvas. Exploring other ideas such as incorporating coloured inks, relief print watercolour and, oil pastels and collage to create soft textures. You will learn some new techniques and each finished piece is still regarded as a pastel painting; we will look at various ideas from the past masters of pastel to create the work.

DAY 1. Landscape Scenes The outback, desert, shoreline or wetlands. Trees, water, mountains, rocks, lakes, pathways etc. Choose a composition you would love to create.

Day 2 Your favourite subject. Still life landscape, seascape, figurative or animals the choice is yours.
